Sub : Recognition Certificate for the School under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 Of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rule, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act,2009

Ref: Inspection Report from Administrative Officer, Thane Municipal Corporation, Education Department, Thane

With reference to your application dated 17/5/2023 and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I Education Officer (Primary), Zilla Parishad, Thane convey the sanction of provisional recognition to the Thane Police School Kharkar Ali, Thane (West) for Class VIII for a period of three years w.e.f. 01/04/2022 to 31/3/2025

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions :-

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize or affiliate beyond Class VIII.
2. The School Shall abide by the provision of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 (Annexure I) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure II)
3. The School Shall admit children in class I to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class. Children belongs to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide them free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed the fee as per 12(2) section of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee from subject or child or his or her parents or guardians for any screening procedure.
6. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof, on the ground of religion, caste, creed or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. The School shall ensure :
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in the school;
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
 - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23;
 - (v) Students with disabilities/special needs be admitted included as per provision of the Act;
 - (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23(1) of The Act. further Provided that the current teachers who; at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 year ;
 - (vii) The teacher should perform his or her duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act
 - (viii) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.

8. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate Authority.
9. The School shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school As prescribed in the section 19 of the Act.
10. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under :

11. No unrecognized classes or divisions shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
12. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
13. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) , or the Bombay Public Trust Act 1950.
14. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person group of person.
15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper account statements should be as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the DEO every year.
16. The recognition Code Number allotted to your school is TH-Thane MNC- P 32--- This may please be noted and quoted for any further correspondence with this office.
17. The school shall furnish reports and information as may be required asked by the Director of Education/ District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the Government or Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continuous fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
18. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
19. Other conditions as per Aneexure 'III' enclosed.
